



## **Holiday Fireworks Festival Sunday, December 14, 2014**

### **Street Closures:**

This event requires closing streets and rerouting traffic in and around the Downtown area. Complete street closures will include:

- Manhattan Beach Boulevard between Pacific Avenue and Ocean Drive.
- Highland Avenue between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 15<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Manhattan Avenue between 9<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Ocean Drive between 8<sup>th</sup> Street and 12<sup>th</sup> Street.

### **Event Timelines:**

#### **Thursday, December 11, 2014**

Public Works will post "Tow - Away, No Parking, Holiday Fireworks Festival" for the following times and locations:

**Sunday, December 14, 2014 - 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.**

- Both sides of Manhattan Beach Boulevard between The Strand and Manhattan Avenue.
- The entrance to the four pier parking lots.
- The motorcycle parking areas on the west side of Ocean Drive north and south of Manhattan Beach Boulevard.
- The bike racks at the base of the pier.

**Sunday, December 14, 2014 - 12:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.**

- Both sides of 13<sup>th</sup> Street between Morningside Drive and Valley Drive.

**Sunday, December 14, 2014 - 2:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.**

- Both sides of Manhattan Beach Boulevard between Manhattan Avenue and Valley Drive.
- The north side of Manhattan Beach Boulevard between Ardmore Avenue and Fisher Street.

**Sunday, December 8, 2013 - 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.**

- Both sides of Manhattan Avenue between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 12<sup>th</sup> Street.
- The south side of 9<sup>th</sup> Street between Highland Avenue and Manhattan Avenue.
- The Civic Center parking lot on 15<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Sunday, December 14, 2014**

0600 hours: Two CSO's will remove illegally parked vehicles, including bicycles, and will barricade Manhattan Beach Boulevard at Manhattan Avenue, and Ocean Drive at 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Street. They will be responsible for maintaining traffic control at those locations and for keeping the roadways clear of spectators for the duration of the build-in.

Three CSC officers will place "Walk Your Bike" signs north and south of the pier and ask riders to dismount. Two CSC officers will barricade the base of the pier and only allow event staff to enter.
